Did you know our Sunday School curriculum is lectionary-based? That means your children are hearing the same stories in class that you're exploring in worship each week!

Most Sunday mornings begin with all of our children gathering together with Gabriel. During this time, they are learning foundational elements of our faith, including the Lord's Prayer, the Ten Commandments, and other meaningful topics.

Afterward, children ages 2 through 2nd grade move to their classroom for a more play-based experience. They enjoy a Bible story followed by a craft or activity, with additional time to play, read, and explore in a nurturing environment.

Our 3rd through 5th graders dive a bit deeper into Scripture, focusing on understanding the Bible itself. Their time together includes a more structured lesson, while still leaving plenty of room for conversation, connection, and fun.

Family Spring Potluck

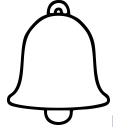

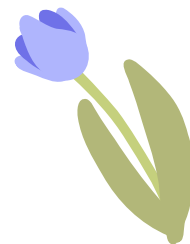
